Completion of Grade Crossing Protective Fund (GCPF) Project

Crossing Surface Improvements at East Main Street (USDOT #852350U)

On January 16, 2014, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) awarded a GCPF grant totaling \$20,000 to Clark County for a project related to crossing surface improvements. Clark County planned to improve the crossing surface by replacing the existing track, structure and surface materials, and installing new mainline rail, hardwood crossties and concrete surface crossing panels. The estimated total project cost was \$184,502.34. The actual total cost of this project was \$163,197.55. Clark County paid the overage of \$143,197.55.

On June 4, 2015, Clark County submitted a request for reimbursement for the project. Rail Safety staff inspected photos and documentation submitted for the project and confirmed that the project was completed according to the specifications outlined in the order approving the grant.
