RE: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Penalty Assessment No. TV-151656

Dear Ms. Bergman:

As you are aware, on October 15, 2015, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued Order 02 ordering Alice the Mover to cease and desist operating as a household goods carrier, and issuing a penalty in the amount of \$5,000 for two violations of RCW 81.80.075, which requires household goods carriers to operate with a permit issued by the Commission. As of November 18, 2015, Alice the Mover has not submitted a household goods carrier application, or refrained from operating as a household goods carrier without a permit. The entire penalty amount of \$5,000 became due and payable on November 18, 2015. The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated November 25, 2015, indicating that the balance of \$5,000 was due.

The Commission has not received the \$5,000 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$5,000 balance.
