ORDER IMPOSING SUSPENDED PENALTY

In the amount of \$6,100

BACKGROUND

- On April 6, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Order of Consolidation; Order Upgrading Safety Rating; Order Imposing and Suspending Penalties (Order 01). Order 01 required MVP Moving and Storage LLC (MVP Moving) to pay a \$6,100 penalty for 61 violations of WAC 480-15 and Tile 49 C.F.R., a \$3,100 portion of which was suspended for two years conditioned on the Company (1) maintaining a conditional safety rating, (2) refraining from incurring repeat critical violations of WAC 480-15, and (3) paying the \$3,000 portion of the penalty that was not suspended within 10 days of the effective date of Order 01.
- Order 01 became effective on April 27, 2017. Accordingly, the \$3,000 portion of the penalty that was not suspended was due no later than May 8, 2017. Commission records indicate that, to date, MVP Moving has not paid the \$3,000 portion of the penalty as required, nor has the Company contacted Commission staff to request payment arrangements.

DISCUSSION

We find that MVP Moving violated the conditions of Order 01 and impose the \$3,100 suspended portion of the penalty. The Company failed to pay the \$3,000 portion of the penalty that was not suspended by May 8, 2017, as required. MVP Moving, therefore, has failed to fulfill one of the conditions under which the Commission suspended \$3,100 of the assessed penalty, and that penalty amount is now due and payable.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 4 (1) MVP Moving and Storage LLC has not complied with the conditions under which the Commission suspended \$3,100 of the \$6,100 penalty assessment.
- 5 (2) The full \$6,100 penalty is now due and payable.
