Dear Mr. Bui:

As you are aware, on August 14, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued Order 02 classifying Ben's Moving Services as a household goods carrier and ordering Ben's Moving Services to cease and desist operations in the state of Washington. A penalty was assessed in the amount of \$5,000, which was due and payable immediately. The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated September 18, 2019, indicating that the balance of \$5,000 was due.

To date, the Commission has not received payment of the balance due.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$5,000 balance.
