NOTICE SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

and

**NOTICE REQUIRING FILING OF SETTLEMENT DOCUMENTS
(By July 22, 2020)**

RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Shuttle Express, Inc.*,
Docket TC-200151

TO ALL PARTIES:

On May 15, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Complaint against Shuttle Express, Inc., (Shuttle Express or Company) alleging violations of WAC 480-30 (Complaint).

On May 27, 2020, the Commission entered Order 02, Granting Motion to Continue Answer Due Date (Order 02) allowing Shuttle Express until July 6, 2020, to respond to the Complaint.

On June 30, 2020, counsel for Commission staff (Staff) contacted the presiding officer on behalf of the parties to inform the Commission that the parties (Parties) have reached a settlement in principle, and request that the Commission suspend the deadline for Shuttle Express to respond and any potential further proceedings to allow the Parties to memorialize their settlement.

The Commission finds good cause to suspend the procedural schedule to allow the Parties time to memorialize the settlement agreement, and to require the Parties to file such settlement agreement and supporting testimony, or a report on the status of negotiations, by 5 p.m., July 22, 2020. At such time, the Commission will determine what further procedure will be necessary in light of the status of the settlement negotiations.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the procedural schedule in this matter is suspended.

THE COMMISSION GIVES FURTHER NOTICE That the Parties must file a settlement agreement and supporting documentation or a status report no later than July 22, 2020.
