## RE: **Docket UE-200573—Replacement Workpapers**

State Of WASH. AND TRANSP. PacifiCorp dba Pacific Power & Light Company submitted its petition for a declaratory order approving the avoided cost methodology for power purchases from large qualifying facilities, with supporting workpapers, on June 22, 2020. It was recently discovered that the workpapers contained a few formula errors. PacifiCorp is therefore submitting revised workpapers to correct the errors listed below:

- The lookups that calculate monthly Integration and Capacity values were pulling in the wrong values from the annual Schedule QF tables in a few instances.
- The total monthly Integration, Contingency, and Capacity dollars were being applied to both on-peak and off-peak periods, resulting in a double count. The correction splits the dollars based on the value in on-peak and off-peak.

For ease of review, the changed cells are highlighted in yellow in the revised workpapers. PacifiCorp is submitting these workpapers as confidential under WAC 480-07-160 given the market-sensitive nature of the hourly forward market prices and certain resource cost data. PacifiCorp is also providing redacted versions of this information as required by WAC 480-07-160(4)(d).
