Commission Staff Recommendation to Waive Suspended Penalties of Order 01
Dockets TV-200946 and TV-200947 (Consolidated)

Dear Ms. Maxwell:

On January 15, 2021, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission entered Order 01 (Order) in Dockets TV-200946 and TV-200947 (Consolidated). The Order approved Two Men and a Moving Van LLC, d/b/a Move For Less' (Move For Less or Company) safety management plan, maintained the Company's conditional safety rating, and extended the provisional household goods operating period. The Order further assessed a \$3,650 penalty against Move For Less and suspended a \$2,000 portion of the assessed penalty for a period of two years, and then waived, subject to the following conditions:

- a) Commission staff (Staff) must conduct a follow-up investigation approximately six months from the date of the Order;
- b) Move For Less may not incur any repeat violations of critical regulations; and
- c) The Company pays the \$1,650 portion of the penalty that is not suspended.

On March 15, 2021, Move For Less paid the \$1,650 portion of the penalty that was not suspended.

On October 21, 2021, Staff completed the required follow-up investigation. The Company achieved a satisfactory safety rating and did not receive any repeat violations of critical regulations.
