RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. PMC Moving, LLC Commission Staff's Response to Request for Payment Arrangement

Dear Ms. Maxwell:

On May 9, 2022, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a penalty assessment against PMC Moving, LLC, (PMC Moving or Company) in the amount of \$41,400 for violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-15-555, Criminal Background Checks for Prospective Employees; WAC 480-15-560, Equipment Safety Requirements, which adopts Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations (49 C.F.R.) Part 393 – Parts and Accessories Necessary for Safe Operation and 49 C.F.R. Part 396 – Inspection, Repair and Maintenance; and WAC 480-15-570, Driver Safety Requirements, which adopts 49 C.F.R. Part 391 – Qualification of Drivers.

On May 13, 2022, PMC Moving filed with the Commission its application for mitigation of penalties.

On June 9, 2022, the Commission entered Order 01, which granted the Company's request for mitigation. Order 01 reduced the penalty to \$20,850 and suspended a \$10,000 portion of the penalty, subject to conditions.

On June 21, 2022, PMC Moving filed with the Commission a petition for administrative review of Order 01.

On August 1, 2022, the Commission entered Order 02, which denied the Company's petition for administrative review and instructed PMC Moving to either pay the \$10,850 portion of the penalty that is not suspended within 90 days or file jointly with Commission staff (Staff) a proposed payment arrangement within 20 days.

On August 2, 2022, Staff and PMC Moving came to a mutual agreement on a proposed payment plan, as follows:

Installment	Due Date	Amount
1	October 3, 2022	\$2,000
2	January 3, 2023	\$2,000
3	April 3, 2023	\$2,000
4	July 3, 2023	\$2,000
5	October 3, 2023	\$2,850

Staff recommends the Commission grant the Company's request for payment arrangements. PMC Moving is aware that if it fails to pay any installment by the due date, the entire remaining balance, including the suspended penalty, will immediately become due and payable without further Commission order.
