NOTICE CANCELING BRIEF ADJUDICATIVE PROCEEDING (Previously set for Tuesday, January 30, 2024, at 9:30 a.m.)

TO ALL PARTIES:

On January 9, 2024, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Intent to Cancel; Notice of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding; Setting Time for Oral Statements (NOIC) against Nicholas Hylan, d/b/a Hylan Moving (Hylan Moving or Company). The NOIC, among other things, scheduled a brief adjudicative proceeding (BAP) for January 30, 2024.

On January 12, 2024, in the same docket, the Commission issued a Penalty Assessment of \$4,200 against Hylan Moving.

On January 17, 2024, Hylan Moving submitted a Safety Management Plan (SMP), and on January 22, Hylan Moving responded to the Penalty Assessment by admitting to the violations and requesting mitigation of the fees.

On January 24, 2024, Commission staff (Staff) filed an Evaluation of Safety Management Plan (Evaluation), in which Staff states that it finds the SMP acceptable. In the Evaluation, Staff requests that the Commission cancel the BAP and indicates that the Company had waived its right to a hearing.

Also on January 24, 2024, the Commission reassigned this matter to Administrative Law Judge Paige Doyle.

Due to Staff's approval of the SMP and the Company's waiver, the Commission finds good cause to cancel the BAP currently set for January 30, 2024, and decide this matter on a paper record.
