MEMORANDUM

- On August 9, 2000, the Commission entered the Third Supplemental Order in Docket UE-991832 approving and adopting settlement agreements, rejecting tariff sheets, and authorizing and requiring compliance filing by PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company ("PacifiCorp" or "Company") to effectuate the terms of that Order.
- On December 3, 2001, PacifiCorp filed certain tariff revisions to comply with the Commission's Order. On December 11, 2001, the Company submitted certain substitute tariff pages and corrections to the December 3, 2001 tariff filing after Commission Staff review. The tariff sheets proposed to be effective and one sheet proposed to be cancelled are reflected on Appendix A to this Order, which is incorporated into and made a part of this Order.
- Commission Staff has reviewed the Company's compliance tariff filings and state that they appear to comply in all respects with the Commission's Third Supplemental Order. The Commission finds that the tariff revisions filed by the Company on December 3, 2001, as corrected by the substitute tariff pages submitted on December 11, 2001, comply with the Commission's Third Supplemental Order in Docket UE-991832 and that the tariff revisions should be approved and become effective as filed.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS That the tariff revisions filed by PacifiCorp on December 3, 2001, as corrected by the substitute tariff pages submitted on December 11, 2001, are in accordance with the Third Supplemental Order in this proceeding, and shall become effective as filed. The rates, charges, and conditions set forth in the

tariff revisions are specified as the rates, charges, and conditions to be applicable to service on and after January 1, 2002.

5 THE COMMISSION FURTHER ORDERS That it retains jurisdiction to effectuate the provisions of this and prior Orders entered in this proceeding.
