The purpose of this filing is to comply with the Order, which provides for the allocation and pass through of the gain allocable to customers from PSE’s sale of assets to Jefferson County Public Utility District No. 1. The attached electric tariff sheets reflect the form and rates authorized in the Order.

Paragraph 4 of the Order discussed the methodology for implementing the one-time pass through to customers. A summary of those provisions are reflected in the “Adjustment” section of the enclosed Schedule 133.

As required by WAC 480-07-883(2) a copy of this filing has been served on each party to this proceeding.

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The enclosed tariff sheets reflect issue dates of October 17, 2014, and effective dates of December 1, 2014, by authority of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission in Docket No. UE-132027.

Work papers that demonstrate the derivation of the rates proposed to be implemented by the enclosed tariff sheets are attached herewith in electronic format. In accordance with the Order the enclosed electric tariff filing is based on pass-through of \$59,245,654 compared to total a revenue requirement of \$2,414,336,000 which represents a decrease in electric revenue of 2.8 percent.
