**ADDENDUM**

1 The Commission conducted a prehearing conference in these consolidated proceedings on May 17, 2004, before Administrative Law Judge Dennis J. Moss. The Commission entered its Order No. 03—Prehearing Conference Order on May 19, 2004. Order No. 03 addressed the subject of discovery under the

Commission's procedural rules, yet failed to memorialize certain adjustments to the timing requirements for responses to discovery requests that Staff proposed. No one opposed Staff's recommendation.

2 By this Addendum to Order No. 3, the Commission establishes the following response times for discovery:

1. Parties will respond to discovery requests received on or before September 23, 2004, within 10 business days.
2. Parties will respond to discovery requests received between September 24, 2004, and November 3, 2004, within 7 business days.
3. Parties will respond to discovery requests received on and after November 4, 2004, within 5 business days.
