

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Dear Kalama Telephone Company Customer,

Kalama Telephone Company (“KTC”) has filed for approval from the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (“Commission” or “WUTC”) to increase its revenue by \$33,912 annually which is approximately 2 percent of the revenue. If approved, the increase will take effect December 1, 2022. The rate increases are set forth in the table below.

Please note that if the proposed rates are approved the Access Recovery Charge or ARC of \$3.00 per month for residential customers will go away. This means the net effect on a residential customer’s bill is an increase of \$1.55 per month.

WUTC last approved new rates for KTC on May 1, 2016.

Overall costs to provide service, such as materials and supplies, have increased due to inflation and supply chain shortages.

3. Subscribers to non-published and non-listed service will be required to maintain such service until the first issuance of a directory in which a requested change may be published, or until telephone service is discontinued. Billing for such services will be discontinued with the last regular bill dated before the issuance of the directory in which the change is made.
4. Subscribers to non-published or non-listed service may change from one to the other without incurring an additional monthly charge.

*The telephone number of a subscriber to non-listed or non-published service will be changed, at the subscriber's request, upon payment of a non-recurring charge for such changed, as applicable in schedule 11.
