Pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996, the Commission has received notice of negotiations and/or a petition for arbitration of an interconnection agreement in the above listed docket.

If you would like to be included as an "interested person" on the service list for any of the above dockets, you must notify the Commission in writing within 10 days of the date of this letter. The request must provide the following information: name of one individual, entity (company, organization, etc.) with whom affiliated, mailing address, voice and facsimile telephone numbers. The request must be addressed to the Commission Secretary, Steve McLellan at the above address, and must refer to the caption and docket number noted above.

The primary purpose of the interested persons list is to establish a list of persons who wish to receive notice when any party files a formal request with the Commission for approval of an interconnection agreement, pursuant to 47 USC § 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. Interested persons may comment on the request for approval as set forth below.

Requests for Approval of Arbitrated or Negotiated Agreements: 10 Day Deadline to Comment.  
Any person wishing to comment on a request for approval may do so by filing written comments with the Secretary of the Commission no later than 10 days after the date of filing of the request for approval. Comments shall be served on all parties to the agreement under review and on the service list for the proceeding.
