Dear Ms. Zakrzewski,

Pursuant to Docket PG-041624 (Wrapped Steel Services Assessment Program Second Settlement Agreement), Puget Sound Energy (PSE) is providing the results of the 2009 risk model run for those services within the City of Bellevue. The attached table summarizes the population of services within each mitigation category based upon the results.

There are 3 services that fall within the Priority Replacement mitigation category and 54 that fall within the Scheduled Replacement mitigation category based upon the 2009 model run. These services will be replaced by December 31, 2010.

The 2009 population reflects a net decrease in the total number of services. This net decrease and the changes in the number of services in each mitigation category are a result of replacements through this program, replacements through normal operation and maintenance activities, and refinements to the risk model data.
