**NOTICE REVISING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

**NOTICE OF SETTLEMENT HEARING**  
**(Set for June 19, 2018, at 1:30 p.m.)**

Re: *In the Matter of Pacific Power & Light Company, 2016 Power Cost Adjustment Mechanism, Docket UE-170717*

TO ALL PARTIES:

On June 1, 2017, Pacific Power & Light Company (Pacific Power or Company) submitted to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) its 2016 Power Cost Adjustment Mechanism (PCAM) filing for approval. On October 2, 2017, both Commission staff and Boise White Paper, L.L.C. submitted letters to the Commission requesting that the matter be set for adjudicative proceeding.

On October 23, 2017, the Commission convened a prehearing conference in this docket and adopted an agreed procedural schedule. On October 26, 2017, the Commission entered Order 01; Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Hearing, which established the procedural schedule, including an evidentiary hearing set for April 4, 2018.

On December 22, 2017, the Commission issued a Notice Revising Procedural Schedule and Notice of Hearing, which altered the procedural schedule and set the evidentiary hearing for May 1, 2018.

On April 10, 2018, counsel for Commission staff sent an email to the Administrative Law Judge informing the Commission that parties had reached a settlement in principle and requesting that the Commission suspend the procedural schedule to allow the parties to finalize and file their agreement and supporting documentation. The Commission granted the request, suspended the procedural schedule, and requested that parties suggest hearing dates and filing deadlines. On April 18, 2018, the parties notified the Commission that they had agreed to a filing deadline of May 4 and a hearing date of June 19.

**THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the settlement agreement, supporting testimony, and exhibits are due by 5 p.m. on May 4, 2018.**

**THE COMMISSION GIVES FURTHER NOTICE That it will conduct a hearing on the settlement on June 19, 2018, at 1:30 p.m. in the Commission's hearing room, Room 206, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Dr. SW, Olympia, Washington.**
