- 1 **NATURE OF PROCEEDING.** On July 3, 2014, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) approved the request of Waste Control, Inc. (WCI or Company) to collect a temporary fuel surcharge in the amount of 1.46 percent on less than statutory notice. The surcharge became effective on July 1, 2014, and will expire on September 30, 2014.

- 2 **MOTION TO APPROVE SURCHARGE.** On August 28, 2014, WCI filed a request to revise the temporary fuel surcharge effective September 1, 2014, and with a new expiration date of November 30, 2014, by continuing the amount of 1.46 percent (Motion).¹ The Company stated that it continues to incur increased fuel costs, from \$2.36 per gallon for the base period to \$3.6835 per gallon current price, during the months of June and July 2014.

- 3 On September 12, 2014, the Commission’s regulatory staff (Staff) filed a response to the Company’s Motion, recommending that the Commission approve the fuel surcharge on less than statutory notice.

- 4 The fuel surcharge would temporarily allow the Company to recoup its increased fuel costs. As the Company’s request is reasonable, the request should be approved.

¹ WCI originally filed its Fuel Surcharge Tariff on August 20, 2014, and filed replacement pages on August 28, 2014.

- 5 THE COMMISSION ORDERS That the temporary Special Fuel Surcharge requested by Waste Control, Inc. in its revised August 28, 2014, filing is approved.
