Thank you for your email regarding the proposed move to a new facility located at 1920 Occidental Ave S, Unit A, Seattle, WA 98134 . Please be advised that notification must be sent to Public Health 30 days prior to commencing operation per WAC 173-350-210 Table A(3)(h). Public Health will then have to review your permit/permit exemption application and conduct a pre-opening inspection prior to approval of the activities at the new location. Since your notification was submitted to Public Health last Saturday (03/21/2020) and your proposed start date at the new location is on 03/23/2020, we do not have enough time to approve your exemption status at the new facility at this time.

Please send in a new Notice of Intent (NOI) to Operate under Terms and Conditions for Solid Waste Permit Exemption and we will review within the 30 day time period. In the meantime, please stop commencing operation at the new location and turn in your applications so that it gets through the formal regulatory process . You can still continue to operate at the old facility until appropriate review of your application for the new facility is conducted and operations are approved.

Failure to meet these conditions will limit your business to only non-solid waste items according to WAC 173-350-021 and may result in permitting requirements or enforcement with civil penalties.
