Public Counsel Request No. 007:

Please identify the timeline under which PSE installed Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) meters across its service territory and in Cle Elum, Washington.

Response:

Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) began deploying electric AMI meters in its service territory in March 2018 and began deploying gas modules in June 2018. The installations for Cle Elum officially opened for meter deployment in June 2021.

PSE has completed 90% of AMI installations in Cle Elum. Due to the winter weather conditions in Cle Elum, PSE had to pause deployment in the winter of 2021 and will pause again for the winter of 2022. Deployment will re-open in Cle Elum in the spring of 2023 when weather conditions change.

With respect to the status of AMI installation in the remainder of PSE’s service territory, 85% of the electric meters and 80% of the gas modules have been deployed.
