All,

I wanted to notify you that Qwest will not be able to complete the Yakima Airport CERB Project as indicated in the attached letter and outlined in the attached diagram due to road construction delays by the City of Yakima. After Qwest completes the section depicted by the blue line on the diagram, the only section that remains to be completed is the section depicted by the black line on the diagram. We realize that you have been patient and given Qwest multiple chances to complete the project, but I think you also understand that the delays are largely beyond Qwest's control. Qwest estimates that the cost of placing conduit and fiber necessary to complete the job is approximately \$125,000. One possible course of action would be to leave that amount of money in the project account and when the required road construction is completed, Qwest will complete the job.

We should probably meet to discuss this issue and determine how the remaining funds will be reallocated and disbursed.
