

STIPULATION OF CWA, INC. AND
DIAMOND-WEST TRANSPORTATION
CO., INC.

1 CWA, Inc. ("CWA") and Diamond-West Transportation Co., Inc. ("Diamond-West")
stipulate to the following:

2 Diamond-West agrees to narrow the authority it seeks by revising its restrictive
amendment filed on October 21, 2004 as follows:

3 PASSENGER SERVICE, excluding door-to-door service:

BETWEEN: Seattle and Snoqualmie Pass, including lodges and resorts within
three (3) miles of Snoqualmie Pass[;][**and intermediate points within one mile
of I-90,**] with service to Bellevue, Redmond, Issaquah, North Bend, [and]
Snoqualmie Pass, [**intermediate points, and points within one mile of I-90,**] via I-
90, SR-10, I-405 and SR-520.[**This authority does not include the right to
serve areas within five miles of the Seattle-Tacoma International Airport.**]

4 CWA stipulates that it has no objection to Diamond-West's application, so long as the
Commission adopts Diamond-West's requested authority with the amendments shown above.
CWA will remain a party to this proceeding to ensure that the Commission adopts the
authority as stated above or with amendments that are acceptable to CWA. If the

Commission rejects the above-stated amendment, CWA will request a continuance of the hearing so that it can prepare a case and present witnesses.




