**BACKGROUND**

- 1     On July 11, 2005, H & R Waterworks, Inc. (H & R Waterworks or Company) filed with the Commission revisions to its currently effective Tariff WN U-2.
  
- 2     On August 31, 2005, the Commission entered a Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revisions pending an investigation to determine whether the revisions are fair, just and reasonable.
  
- 3     The Company has provided necessary information for Staff to determine that the rates and charges along with the tariff services are fair, just and reasonable..

**FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS**

- 4     (1)    The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission is an agency of the State of Washington vested by statute with the authority to regulate rates, rules, regulations, practices, accounts, securities, and transfers of public service companies, including water companies. *RCW 80.01.040; Chapter 80.04 RCW and Chapter 80.28 RCW.*

- 5 (2) H & R Waterworks is a water company and is a public service company subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.
- 6 (3) This matter was brought before the Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on September 28, 2005.
- 7 (4) The revised tariff revisions presently under suspension are fair, just, and reasonable.
- 8 (5) After review of the tariff revisions filed in Docket UW-051062 by H & R Waterworks and giving due consideration, the Commission finds it is consistent with the public interest that the Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revisions in Docket UW-051062, dated August 31, 2005, be dismissed.

## **ORDER**

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 9 (1) The Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revisions in Docket UW-051062, dated August 31, 2005, is dismissed.
