BACKGROUND

1 On March 3, 2006, Gold Beach Water Company, Inc. (Gold Beach Water or Company) filed with the Commission revisions to its currently effective Tariff WN U-2, designated as:

Fourth Revision Sheet No. 21 canceling Third Revision Sheet No. 21.
Third Revision Sheet No. 22 canceling Second Revision Sheet No. 22.
First Revision Sheet No. 30 canceling Original Sheet No. 30.
The stated effective date is May 1, 2006.

2 On April 26, 2006, the Commission entered a Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revisions pending an investigation to determine whether the revisions are fair, just and reasonable.

3 On June 7, 2006 the company filed revised rates. The revised filing would produce about \$10,000 (17 percent) of additional revenue per year.

4 The company's books and records show that the company has justified it needs additional revenue.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

- 5 (1) The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission is an agency of the State of Washington vested by statute with the authority to regulate rates, rules, regulations, practices, accounts, securities, and transfers of public service companies, including water companies. *RCW 80.01.040, Chapter 80.04 RCW, Chapter 80.28 RCW, Chapter 80.08 RCW and Chapter 80.12 RCW.*
- 6 (2) Gold Beach Water is a water company and is a public service company subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.
- 7 (3) This matter was brought before the Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on June 14, 2006.
- 8 (4) The tariff revisions presently under suspension are fair, just and reasonable.
- 9 (5) After review of the tariff revisions filed in Docket UW-060352 by Gold Beach Water and giving due consideration, the Commission finds it is consistent with the public interest that the Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revisions in Docket UW-060352, dated April 26, 2006, be dismissed and the revised tariff revisions, dated June 7, 2006, to Tariff WN U-2 become effective on July 1, 2006.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 10 (1) The Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revision(s) in Docket UW-060352, dated April 26, 2006, is dismissed.
- 11 (2) The revised tariff revisions filed in this docket on June 7, 2006, shall become effective on July 1, 2006.
