Definitions for both terms (identical to those in RCW 81.88.010) are being added to WAC 480-93-005 under this rulemaking so it seems unnecessary to reference the RCW. Also, there is no need to refer to hazardous liquid pipelines in WAC 480-93. Therefore, the paragraph should read “...regulatory fee paid by <u>a gas pipelines pipeline company</u> as that term is defined <u>herein</u>. and hazardous liquid pipelines as that term is defined in RCW 81.88.010. For the purposes of this section, <u>these gas pipelines are a gas pipeline company is</u> called “company” or “companies” and . . .”</p>	<p>Agree with most of the proposed change – rule has been amended to include the proposed change except for “”herein” language.</p>
