Dear Mr. Johnson:

On October 25, 2017, the Commission issued Order 02 in docket TV-170746, classifying Bogdan Momotyuk, d/b/a Bogdan Delivery, LLC, (Bogdan Delivery or Company), as a common carrier of household goods within the state of Washington. The Commission also assessed a penalty in the amount of \$5,000, suspending \$4,000 of the penalty for two years on the condition that Mr. Momotyuk not operate as a household goods mover without the required permit.

On November 7, 2017, Mr. Momotyuk applied to the Commission for a household goods mover permit, as BM Logistics, d/b/a Bogdan Movers. The Commission granted permit THG-67933 on November 17, 2017, and cancelled the permit for lack of insurance on September 14, 2018. On January 8, 2019, Commission staff observed online advertising for Bogdan Movers, and contacted the company and received an offer for for-hire intrastate moving services.

Mr. Momotyuk has continued to operate as a household goods mover without authority and is in violation of the terms of Order 02. Staff requests the Commission impose the \$4,000 suspended portion of the penalty imposed in Order 02.
