RE: *In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment Against Tiraogo Simpure, d/b/a TS Moving Services, in the Amount of \$5,000, Dockets TV-190298 & TV-190299 (Consolidated)*

TO ALL PARTIES:

On June 4, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a penalty assessment (Penalty Assessment) against Tiraogo Simpure, d/b/a TS Moving Services, (TS Moving or Company) in the amount of \$5,000 for violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-15. On June 20, 2019, the Commission entered Order 01, Order of Consolidation; Order Extending Provisional Permit; Order Imposing and Suspending Penalties, which imposed a reduced penalty of \$3,800, a \$2,500 portion of which was suspended subject to the conditions that the Company (a) must not incur any repeat violations of critical regulations upon reinspection, and (b) must pay the \$1,300 portion of the penalty that was not suspended or file a proposed payment arrangement within 10 days of the effective date of Order 01.

On July 8, 2019, the Commission entered Order 02, Granting Payment Arrangement (Order 02). Order 02 approved a payment plan that permitted TS Moving to pay the \$1,300 portion of the penalty that was not suspended in 12 monthly installments. The Company paid the final installment in December 2020.

On June 30, 2021, Staff filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that TS Moving had not incurred any repeat violations of critical regulations and that Staff believes the Company has complied with all the conditions of Order 01.

The Commission finds that TS Moving has complied with the conditions of Order 01. The \$2,500 portion of the penalty that was suspended is now waived, and this docket is closed.
