NOTICE SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

and

NOTICE REQUIRING FILING OF SETTLEMENT DOCUMENTS OR STATUS REPORT (by March 20, 2020)

RE: In the Matter of Determining the Proper Carrier Classification of, and Complaint for Penalties Against Westside Waste, LLC, Docket TG-190672

TO ALL PARTIES:

On November 8, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01 in this docket, initiating a complaint on its own motion against Westside Waste, LLC, (Westside Waste or Company) for operating as a solid waste carrier without the certificate required by RCW 81.77.040.

On December 23, 2019, the Commission entered Order 02, Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding (Order 02). Order 02, among other things, established a procedural schedule including a brief adjudicative proceeding on March 16, 2020.

On March 5, 2020, Commission staff (Staff) notified the Commission that the parties had reached a settlement in principle, requested the procedural schedule be suspended, and indicated the parties intended to file a settlement agreement.

The Commission finds good cause to suspend the procedural schedule and therefore grants the parties' request. The parties must file either a settlement agreement and supporting

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documentation or a report on the status of their settlement negotiations by Friday, March 20, 2020.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the procedural schedule in this matter is suspended. The parties must file either a settlement agreement and supporting documentation or a status report of their negotiations no later than March 20, 2020.
