RE: Numbering Resources, Docket UT-991627

Dear Mr. Weaver:

The Federal Communication Commission (FCC) gave states authority under 47 CFR Sec. 52.15(i) to require that service providers return number resources to the NANPA or the Pooling Administrator.¹

The Utilities and Transportation Commission (commission) staff identified WeavTel as holding number resources that far exceed customer and internal company requirements. The company has three - 1,000 blocks of numbers assigned to it for a total of 3,000 numbers. Less than ten percent of the numbers in each one thousand block has been assigned. Furthermore, WeavTel has not filed the required 2008 and 2009 "Utilization Resource Reports" with North American Number Plan Administrator (NANPA).

In March 2009, WeavTel provided to commission staff the following utilization as of December 31, 2007:

- 509-699-2 Five numbers assigned (an additional three numbers assigned to company)
- 509-699-4 Five numbers assigned
- 509-699-6 No numbers assigned (three numbers assigned for company use)


Action Required:

Return block 509-699-4 and block 509-699-6 to the FCC's Pooling Administrator because each block is under the FCC's required utilization of ten percent.

Timeline:

Return resources by August 15, 2009, otherwise the FCC's number administrator, NeuStar could be directed to reclaim them.
