Dear Mr. Johnson:

On November 27, 2002, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered its Final Order in the above-referenced docket, which rejected Pacific Power & Light Company's (Pacific Power or Company) original proposed tariff revision and approved its modified tariff proposal (Final Order). The Final Order required Pacific Power to make annual compliance filings reporting the number of times Rules 4 and 6 of its Permanent Disconnection and Removal Tariff were used, and, for each transaction: the date, customer type, nature of the request, estimated removal cost and salvage, actual removal cost and salvage, description of the facilities removed, and the accounts used to book the transaction.

On February 27, 2020, the Company made its annual Compliance Filing for 2019. Commission Staff believes that the filing complies fully with the Commission's Order 08, entered November 27, 2002.
