- c. See Attachment PC-6 for an excerpt from Verizon's F.C.C No. 20 Tariff, which gives the rates for Verizon's Tariffed DSL services.
- d. Total interstate revenues of \$3,299,084 were recorded by Verizon Northwest Washington in connection with FCC-tariffed DSL loop services. All of these revenues are determined to be interstate in nature, therefore, were not included in the calculation of the revenue deficiencies in this case.
