Pursuant to the procedural schedule for the above entitled docket, the Public Counsel Unit of the Washington Office of the Attorney General (“Public Counsel”) respectfully submits this report regarding the status of Cascade Natural Gas Corporation’s (“Cascade” or “Company”) Customer Notice. In an earlier report filed in this docket on September 4, 2020, Public Counsel stated that it would submit a subsequent Customer Notice Report on Friday, October 2, 2020.

The Company provided another draft of the Customer Notice to parties in this proceeding on September 29, 2020. 
