Enclosed is the original and three copies of Puget Sound Energy, Inc.'s (the "Company") revised 2011 Exhibit 4; EES List of Measures, Incentives and Eligibility, which was originally filed in Docket No. UE-100177 on December 1, 2010.

This revision is consistent with Section 10 of the Company's Annual Conservation Plan overview, which indicates that Exhibit 4 will be updated quarterly (at a minimum) and the 2010 Electric Settlement Agreement in Docket No. UE-100177, condition K(5), which indicates that program details must be maintained as tariff attachments with the Commission. Additionally, condition K(7)(a) of the 2010 Electric Settlement Agreement indicates that program modifications must be filed with the Commission as revisions to tariffs or as revisions to PSE's Annual Conservation Plan ("ACP"), as appropriate.

The enclosed updated exhibit dated April, 2011 replaces, in total, the ACP version of Exhibit 4 currently on file, dated January, 2011. The Company provided advance copies of the ACP, including a draft version and a table outlining the measure changes that have taken place from January through March 2011, to the Conservation Resource Advisory Group (CRAG) via email on April 8, 2011. The Company has not received any comments from the CRAG as a result of that email with attachments.
