NOTICE OF DEADLINE TO RESPOND TO STAFF MOTION FOR LEAVE TO REVISE THE TESTIMONIES AND EXHIBITS OF STAFF WITNESSES ERDAHL, MCGUIRE AND CHEESMAN

TO ALL PARTIES:

On January 13, 2017, Puget Sound Energy (PSE or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) revisions to its currently effective Tariffs for electric and natural gas services the Company provides in Washington. The effect of these filings would be to increase rates and charges for electric service and decrease rates and charges for natural gas service. The Commission suspended the as-filed tariffs and set the matters for hearing in Order 01 on January 19, 2017. In Order 03, the Commission, among other things, established a procedural schedule including dates for parties to file Supplemental testimony, Response testimony, Cross-Answering testimony, and Rebuttal testimony.

Commission staff (Staff) and other parties filed Response testimony on June 30, 2017, in accordance with the procedural schedule. Cross-Answering and Rebuttal testimonies are scheduled to be filed today.

On August 8, 2017, Staff filed a Motion for Leave to Revise the Testimonies and Exhibits of Betty A. Erdahl, Christopher R. McGuire, and Melissa C. Cheesman (Motion). Staff requests leave to make substantive changes to the testimony and exhibits of Ms. Erdahl, Mr. McGuire, and Ms. Cheesman due to errors in their testimonies and in response to new information they obtained after the original testimony was filed. Among other things, these changes will have a material impact on Staff's overall revenue requirements.

Due to the proximity of the hearing and looming deadlines, parties who intend to respond to this motion must do so no later than 2 p.m., Friday, August 11, 2017.
