BETWEEN: Oak Harbor and the SeaTac International Airport via SR20 and, SR525 to, the Clinton-Mukilteo Ferry, via SR525, SR526, Interstate 5, direct to SeaTac. Door to door service in conjunction with the above route with pickup points within 1 mile of on SR20 and SR525 originating on Whidboy Island and terminating at SeaTac. Closed door service between Clinton and Sea-Tac.

ALTERNATE ROUTE: In the event that the Clinton-Mukilteo Ferry service is not available or there are no other reservations for passengers on the above named route south of Oak Harbor the company may for any individual trip elect to utilize the following alternate route: SR525, SR20, Interstate 5 via Burlington, with closed door service between Oak Harbor and Sea-Tac.


