1 Household Goods Permit No. HG-11881 stands in the name of Don C. Risk, Jr., d/b/a People Movers, and authorizes the services therein set forth.

2 On August 29, 2004, Docket No. TV-031016 was issued suspending Household Goods Permit No. HG-11881 for failure to file acceptable proof of liability and property damage insurance with this Commission.

3 Mr. Risk has requested that Permit No. HG-11881 be further suspended. Mr. Risk is currently seeking reinstatement of his insurance policy and has requested additional time.

4 The Commission having reviewed the circumstances and being fully advised of the facts and noting that Don C. Risk, Jr., d/b/a People Movers, will not be operating vehicles under his Household Goods permit authority, is of the opinion that it would not be detrimental to the interest of the public to further suspend Household Goods permit HG-11881 until October 29, 2004.

ORDER

5 Therefore, this order further suspends Household Goods Permit No. HG-11881. As the certificate is suspended, the holder is directed to cease all operations associated with this permit. To avoid cancellation, the certificate holder must file acceptable proof of insurance or request a hearing by October 29, 2004 to show why the certificate should not be canceled.
