The Commission's Order 02 in this docket, which became final on February 29, 2008, by operation of law, calls for Careful Movers to pay a \$2,000 penalty and make regular payments of that penalty in accordance with the terms of a payment plan determined by Commission Staff. This letter is to notify the Commission of Staff's determination.

Staff has determined the following payment plan is appropriate in this case:

If the Commission has received from Careful Movers a completed application for authority to operate as a household goods mover by April 1, 2008, Careful Movers must pay the penalty to the Commission in regular monthly installments not to exceed six months, of \$333.33, \$333.33, \$333.33, \$333.33, \$333.33, \$333.34, with the first payment due April 1, 2008, and each subsequent payment due by the first of each month following.

If the Commission has <u>not</u> received from Careful Movers a completed application for authority to operate as a household goods mover by April 1, 2008, Careful Movers must pay the penalty in regular monthly installments not to exceed three months, of \$666.66, \$666.66, and \$666.67, with the first payment due April 1, 2008, and each subsequent payment due by the first of each month following.

If Careful Movers fails to comply with the terms of the payment plan as outlined above, the entire amount shall be due and payable immediately.
