NOTICE WAIVING SUSPENDED PENALTY

RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Stillaguamish Senior Center*
Docket TN-170131

TO ALL PARTIES:

On May 17, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Order of Consolidation; Order Upgrading Safety Rating; Order Imposing and Suspending Penalties (Order 01) in the above-referenced docket. Order 01 assessed a \$3,600 penalty against Stillaguamish Senior Center (SSC or Company) for violations of Commission safety rules. The Commission suspended a \$2,600 portion of the penalty subject to the following conditions: 1) SSC must maintain a conditional safety rating, 2) SSC may not incur any repeat critical violations of Commission safety rules upon re-inspection in one year, and 3) SSC must pay the remaining \$1,000 penalty within 10 days of the effective date of Order 01.

On May 18, 2018, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that the Company has satisfied all of the conditions set out in Order 01, and recommending that the Commission waive the suspended portion of the penalty and close the docket.

The Commission has reviewed the record in this docket and accepts Staff's recommendation. The Commission waives the suspended portion of the penalty and closes Docket TN-170131.
