RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. James Moseley, d/b/a You Got It Movers*
Commission Staff's Response to Request for Payment Arrangements
Dockets TV-190808 and TV-190809 (*Consolidated*)

Dear Mr. Johnson:

On October 2, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) assessed a \$6,200 penalty in Docket TV-190809 against James Moseley, d/b/a You Got It Movers (You Got It Movers or Company), for violations of WAC 480-15-555, Criminal Background Checks for Prospective Employees; WAC 480-15-560, Equipment Safety Requirements, which adopts Title 49 CFR Part 396 – Inspection, Repair and Maintenance; and WAC 480-15-570, Driver Safety Requirements, which adopts Title 49 CFR Part 391 – Qualification of Drivers.

On November 20, 2019, the Commission issued Order 01 granting mitigation to \$3,200. In addition, the Commission suspended a \$2,000 portion of the penalty for a period of two years before being waived, subject to the conditions that: (1) You Got It Movers maintains a conditional safety rating, (2) Commission staff (Staff) conducts a follow-up investigation at least six months from the date of the order, (3) You Got It Movers not incur any repeat critical violations upon re-inspection, (4) the Company's owner and assistant manager attend Commission-sponsored household goods training, and (5) You Got It Movers pays the \$1,200 penalty within 10 days of the date of the order or works with Staff to establish mutually agreeable payment arrangements.

On December 10, 2019, Staff and You Got It Movers came to a mutual agreement on a proposed payment plan, as follows:

You Got It Movers is aware that if it fails to pay any installment by the due date, the entire remaining balance, including the suspended penalty, will become immediately due and payable without further Commission order.
