RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Jack Chapman, Jr. d/b/a J & T Hauling Commission Staff's Recommendation to Waive Suspended Penalties of Order 02 Docket TG-210005

Dear Mr. Killip:

On December 1, 2021, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 02, which assessed Jack Chapman, Jr. d/b/a J & T Hauling (Chapman or Company) a penalty of \$2,000 for operating as a solid waste carrier without a certificate. Order 02 further suspended a \$1,500 portion of the penalty for a period of two years on the conditions that: (1) the Company refrains permanently from further operations as a solid waste carrier in the state of Washington without first obtaining the required certificate, and (2) Chapman pays the \$500 portion of the penalty that is not suspended.

On March 22, 2022, the Company completed payments of the \$500 penalty. To date, Chapman has refrained permanently from further operations as a solid waste carrier in this state. Staff finds that Chapman satisfied the conditions of Order 02 and recommends that the \$1,500 suspended penalty be waived.
