WUTC Staff has requested information to supplement The Toledo Telephone Co., Inc. petition to receive State Universal Service funds.

At the time of the filing, the company has 1,790 broadband subscribers and had built out fiber services to 2200 locations. There are very few households that do not subscribe to our services, the other unsubscribed locations are where the company has fiber in the right-of-way ready to serve tax parcels awaiting new single family construction. Fiber will still need to be placed from the right-or-way to the home, no additional right-of-way construction will be required.

The certifications and reports that were requested by staff are enclosed.

The Company also respectfully requests a waiver of the August 2nd filling date set forth in WAC 480-123-110(5). The basis for the waiver is that the undersigned was seriously ill fir several days before and following August 2nd. Than you for consideration of this request.
