RE: DISH Wireless, L.L.C. d/b/a Gen Mobile (initial compliance filing) **Docket UT-230144**

Dear Mr. Killip:

On January 30, 2025, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, "GRANTING PETITION FOR DESIGNATION AS ELIGIBLE TELECOMMUNICATIONS CARRIER DESIGNATION AND EXEMPTIONS FROM WAC CODE 480-123-030(1)(d), (f), AND (g)," in the above-referenced docket. Order 01, among other things, required DISH Wireless, L.L.C. (Company) to provide an initial compliance filing within 30 days (prior to offering Lifeline services). ¹

On February 27, 2025, the company submitted its initial compliance filing including the following information to meet the requirements of Condition number one:

- a. DISH Wireless's Lifeline rate plans, terms, and conditions. The rates, terms and conditions shall include all provisions that apply to the Lifeline services offered by DISH Wireless, L.L.C. in Washington State and detailed procedures explaining how customers can participate in a particular Lifeline plan.
- b. DISH Wireless's proposed language is to be used in all advertising of Lifeline services and on its websites. The language shall include information directing customers to the Washington State Office of the Attorney General for complaints regarding any Lifeline service issues.
- c. DISH Wireless's Lifeline Customer Application Form.

Based on Commission Staff's review of the compliance filing, Staff believes that DISH Wireless, L.L.C. d/b/a Gen Mobile compliance filing should be approved, and recommends the Commission issue a Compliance Acknowledgment Letter approving this filing so that the Company may then begin to offer its services to low-income consumers in Washington.
