NOTICE SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

And

NOTICE CANCELING EVIDENTIARY HEARING

RE: *In the Matter of Determining the Proper Carrier Classification of, and Complaint for Penalties Against, Somers Sunrise Enterprises, LLC,*
Docket TG-230191

TO ALL PARTIES:

On May 9, 2023, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Instituting Special Proceeding; Complaint Seeking to Impose Penalties; Notice of Prehearing Conference (Order 01). Order 01 alleged that Somers Sunrise Enterprises, LLC (Somers or Company) violated the Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 81.80.70(1) and RCW 81.77.040 a total of 90 times between July 1, 2022, and January 31, 2023.

On May 23, 2023, the Commission entered Order 02, Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Hearing (Order 02). Order 02 established a procedural schedule including, among other things, an evidentiary hearing set for July 18, 2023.

On June 26, 2023, Commission staff (Staff) contacted the presiding officer on behalf of the parties to indicate that the parties had reached a settlement in principle, and to request the Commission suspend the procedural schedule to allow time for the parties to memorialize their settlement and file a request to proceed on a paper record.

Due to the parties' agreement, the Commission finds good cause to suspend the procedural schedule to allow the parties to finalize a settlement.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the procedural schedule in this matter is suspended.

THE COMMISSION GIVES FURTHER NOTICE That the evidentiary hearing scheduled for July 18, 2023, is canceled.
