- 1 On January 13, 2020, Lake Union Ferry Company, LLC and Eden Valley Investments LLC d/b/a Lake Union Ferry Company filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a joint application requesting authority to transfer all rights under certificate BC068215 from Eden Valley Investments LLC d/b/a Lake Union Ferry Company to Lake Union Ferry Company, LLC.
- 2 Certificate of public convenience and necessity BC068215 is held by Eden Valley Investments LLC d/b/a Lake Union Ferry Company and authorizes the service described in the certificate.
- 3 The Commission, having considered the application and being fully advised, finds that Lake Union Ferry Company, LLC is fit, willing and able to provide all services necessary under certificate BC068215, and that the transfer of all rights to Lake Union Ferry Company, LLC as requested will not be detrimental to the public interest.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 4 (1) The application filed in Docket TS-200032 to transfer all rights in the state of Washington from Eden Valley Investments LLC d/b/a Lake Union Ferry Company to Lake Union Ferry Company LLC is granted.
- 5 (2) Certificate of public convenience and necessity BC068215 is reissued to Lake Union Ferry Company, LLC as described in the attached Appendix A.

- 6 (3) Granting authority for the transfer of rights under a certificate does not necessarily
approve the amount involved in the transaction, nor does it bind the Commission
to recognize the amount in placing a value for rate-making purposes on the
property of the certificate holder.
- 7 (4) The tariff filed in connection with this application will become effective at 12:01
a.m. on the day following the service date of this Order.
- 8 (5) Lake Union Ferry Company, LLC shall comply with the Revised Code of
Washington 81.84 and Washington Administrative Code 480-51 in addition to
rules prescribed by the commission for public service companies in general.
- 9 The Commission has delegated authority to the Secretary to enter this Order under RCW
80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-905(2).

NOTICE: This is an order delegated to the Secretary for decision. In addition to serving you a copy of the decision, the Commission will post on its Internet Web site for at least 14 days a listing of all matters delegated to the Secretary for decision. You may seek Commission review of this decision. You must file a request for Commission review of this order no later than fourteen (14) days after the date the decision is posted on the Commission's Web site.

The Commission will schedule your request for review by issuing a notice of hearing to be held before an administrative law judge. The Commission, at its discretion, may consider your request for review in an adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05 Part IV, or in a brief adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05.482 through .494. Following hearing, the administrative law judge will enter an initial order. If you wish to seek review of the initial order, you may file a petition for administrative review under RCW 34.05.464, or if the matter is heard in a brief adjudicative proceeding, under RCW 34.05.491.

The Commission will grant a late-filed request for review only on a showing of good cause, including a satisfactory explanation of why the person did not timely file the request. A form for late-filed requests is available on the Commission's Web site.

This notice and review process is pursuant to the provisions of RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-904(2) and (3), and WAC 480-07-905, as amended effective September 24, 2015.
