NOTICE OF INTENT TO TAKE NOTICE; OPPORTUNITY TO RESPOND

RE: *In the Matter of the Investigation of MARIK MOVERS, LLC for Compliance with WAC 480-14-300, WAC 480-15-560, and WAC 480-15-590, Docket TV-231020*

TO ALL PARTIES:

On December 28, 2023, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Intent to Cancel Permit as a Household Goods Carrier; Notice of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding; Setting Time for Oral Statements (NOIC) against Marsik Movers LLC (Marsik Movers or Company). This NOIC set a Cancellation Deadline of February 13, 2024. On February 12, 2024, this deadline was moved to February 29, 2024.

Pursuant to WAC 480-07-495(2)(iv), the presiding officer intends to take official notice of any and all portions of the FMCSA's online Safety Measurement System database entries related to USDOT #3257682. Specifically, those pages related to federally tracked safety inspections,¹ federal operating authority status,² and reported reportable crashes of the

¹ For 2023, there are at least eight federally tracked safety inspections affiliated with USDOT #3257682; six of which found violations. Of particular concern, are two violations which occurred in the 365 days preceding the November 16, 2023, investigation start date: (1) WAW821002517 is dated March 31, 2023, which indicates that a driver of the Company violated 49 CFR § 392.4A (Driver on Duty and In Possession of a Narcotic Drug Amphetamine), [Safety Measurement System - Inspection WAW821002517 \(U.S. DOT# 3257682\)](#); (2) and WAW804004656 is dated November 4, 2022, which indicates that a driver of the Company had violated 49 CFR §392.2, a safety critical regulation. Company.³ Similarly, the presiding officer intends to take official notice of any and all portions of the FMCSA's Licensing and Insurance Public Portal, related to USDOT #3257682.⁴

Pursuant to WAC 480-07-495(2)(iv), the presiding officer intends to take notice of any and all portions of the FMCSA's Safety Measurement System entries related to USDOT #4176081.

Pursuant to WAC 480-07-495(c), both parties are afforded the opportunity to contest the facts and material of which the presiding officer intends to take official notice. The parties have until the close of business, February 19, 2024, to so contest. Alternatively, please inform the presiding officer if there is no objection.
