The Consolidation Amendment provides that GTE Mobilnet Incorporated and Verizon Wireless fka U.S. West NewVector Group Inc's Interconnection Agreement with Qwest, Docket No.UT-970307, approved May 28, 1997, will terminate and the parties will operate under the successor Interconnection Agreement with Qwest, approved in Docket No. UT-970314 on August 27, 1997, (the "Surviving ICA"). The Consolidation Amendment modifies the Surviving ICA as set forth in Attachment 1A and Attachment 1B. In addition, several new entities have been identified as contracting with Qwest in the Surviving Agreement. Verizon Wireless has requested that each entity which holds a license for wireless spectrum separately enter into the Surviving Agreement with Qwest, but has stated, according to the terms of the Consolidation Amendment, that ordering and provisioning will be commonly done through Verizon Wireless.

Verizon Wireless and Qwest jointly submit the Amendment, and Verizon Wireless has authorized Qwest to submit this Notice Letter on its behalf.

Qwest has also enclosed a completed Request for Approval form. The enclosed Amendment does not discriminate against non-party carriers. It is consistent with state and federal law, and is in the public interest.

Qwest respectfully requests that the Commission approve this Amendment expeditiously.
