This is to request a one-day extension of time to file briefs addressing Checklist Items 1 (Interconnection), 14 (Resale) and 11 (Number Portability). On October 25, 2000, Administrative Law Judge Rendahl entered her Fifth Supplemental Order in the above captioned proceeding establishing January 22, 2001 as the date for filing post workshop 2 briefs.
