PACIFICORP'S MOTION TO  
ALLOW SUPPLEMENTAL  
TESTIMONY

**I. INTRODUCTION**

1 Consistent with Wash. Admin. Code 480-07-375(1)(d) and 480-07-460(1)(a)(i)  
PacifiCorp dba Pacific Power & Light Company (PacifiCorp) requests leave to supplement  
the testimony originally filed on June 1, 2021, with the Supplemental Testimony of Douglas  
R. Staples providing additional information regarding PacifiCorp's proposed Nodal Pricing  
Model and the transition to Aurora for modeling net power costs.

**II. PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND**

2 On June 1, 2021, PacifiCorp filed a power cost only rate case (PCORC), including the  
direct testimony of Mr. Staples, which among other issues, supported PacifiCorp's forecast  
net power costs. On June 25, 2021, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission  
(Commission) issued a Pre-Hearing Conference Order that set a procedural schedule.

**III. PACIFICORP'S MOTION**

3 Under Wash. Admin. Code 480-07-375(1)(d) and 480-07-460(1)(a)(i) a party may  
request leave to add to the evidentiary record in a proceeding and file substantive changes to  
its direct testimony. PacifiCorp now requests leave of the Commission to allow the filing of  
supplemental testimony in this proceeding to provide certain additional information
