TO ALL PARTIES:

On May 26, 2021, in a recessed open meeting, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) will hear from all regulated energy companies on their preparedness for the upcoming wildfire season, including plans for fire mitigation strategies, as well as communication plans with state, federal, and local emergency response agencies and customers.

On May 25, 2021, Avista Corporation d/b/a Avista Utilities (Avista) filed with the Commission its Wildfire Resiliency Plan (Plan) in Docket U-210254. The Plan is also filed in Avista's currently pending general rate case in consolidated Dockets UE-200900 and UG-200901.

The Commission hereby gives notice to the parties to the general rate case in consolidated Dockets UE-200900 and UE-200901 that the Commission has filed Avista's Plan in recessed open meeting Docket U-210254 for discussion limited to Avista's preparedness for the upcoming 2021 wildfire season.
