NOTICE TO COMMISSION**

1           On December 22, 2022, the Utilities and Transportation Commission (“Commission”) issued its Final Order, Order No. 24/10, in Docket UE-220066/UG-220067 and UG-210918 (consolidated), which approved with conditions several multi-party settlements in these proceedings. Nucor Steel Seattle, Inc. is a signatory to two multi-party settlement agreements, including (i) the Settlement Stipulation and Agreement on Revenue Requirement and All Other Issues Except Tacoma Liquefied Natural Gas (“LNG”) and Puget Sound Energy’s (“PSE”) Green Direct Program (“Revenue Requirement Settlement”), and (ii) the Amended Settlement Stipulation and Agreement on Tacoma LNG (“Tacoma LNG Settlement”).

2           Pursuant to WAC 480-07-750(2)(b), Nucor Steel Seattle, Inc. hereby accepts the additional conditions to the Revenue Requirement Settlement and Tacoma LNG settlement as described in Final Order No. 24/10, in Dockets UE-220066/UG-220067 and UG-210918.
