## TO ALL PARTIES:

On June 19, 2020, Cascade Natural Gas Corporation (Cascade or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) revisions to its currently effective Tariff WN U-3 for natural gas service. The purpose of the filing is to increase rates and charges for natural gas service provided to customers in the state of Washington. Specifically, Cascade requests authority to increase charges and rates for natural gas service by approximately \$13.8 million, or 5.283 percent in base rates.

On July 13, 2020, the Commission entered its Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Hearing (PHC Notice), which established a procedural schedule that allowed for a public comment hearing on January 26, 2021. The PHC Notice stated that the Commission would determine at a later date whether in-person attendance would be permitted.

The Commission has determined that the public comment hearing will be strictly virtual. Members of the public will have an opportunity to present oral comments to the Commission by phone or live via Microsoft Teams. Commission headquarters will not be open to the public during the hearing due to the ongoing COVID-19 public health crisis.
